Making Connections in Your Brain and Community

Based on Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST) and delivered by friendly, trained professionals, our weekly COGS session combines a number of different activities all designed to make new connections within your brain and community.

Thursday Mornings from 10.30am-12noon Ladybrook Community Centre, Mansfield, NG18 5JJ

Group members take part in stimulating activities, proven to help maintain memory and mental functioning. The group provides a safe and supportive environment where people and their carers can build new connections to their community, gain support and have fun!

Activities include:

Discussions, Word Games. Quizzes

Physical Activities, Creative and Musical Activities and More!

The session is suitable for those with a mild to moderate dementia diagnosis and their carers as well as those that are experiencing memory loss but have not yet received a formal diagnosis.
